ONGOING WORKS BEHIND KS1 PLAYGROUND

Essex Highways are working to improve the town, from the train station up to the library. They are clearing the wooded/waste area behind the KS1 playgrounds and will be putting down a stone base to set up a storage facility and daily meeting area compound whilst the work is being done. It is likely to take 6 months to complete. There will be cones near the entrance to the site and they will need to remain as there will be lorries turning in with equipment/materials for the work they are doing and there is a risk of damage to any cars parked there.
